- Federal Transition Discussion (Hillary Fouts)
 - Open discussion on the impact on programs and students, the following topics were discussed:
 - Concern was raised by faculty over UCCS appearing on Dept of Ed list of universities under investigation
 - Students have been dropping emphasizes to finish degree faster to potentially find a new job due to concerns of potential workplace changes
 - Students are concerned with taking out student loans and are looking for more aid from UCCS
 - Concerns raised over students looking to finish their degree online so they can return to their home state
 - Program-specific accreditation concerns were expressed based on different guidelines from accreditors and the federal government.
